2nd Phase of Training after completion of Six months

On completion of the period of Six months training the officers who had completed 3 years practice at the Bar shall be released from the Academy. The officers who have not completed 3 years practice at the Bar shall be given further training for a period of 6 months as under:

- a) The High Court shall depute the officers to the District Courts and Sub-Divisional Courts for a period of 3 months to watch the proceedings in the Civil and Criminal Courts and to record the proceedings in the diary maintained by each of such officers. On completion of the training, they will submit a report to the Director, Manipur Judicial Academy
- b) After completion of the deputation period there will be a gap of two weeks. This shall be followed by 10 weeks training in the Judicial Academy. In this period the officers will give the feedbacks and give efforts to remove all doubts in the mind of the trainees as regard the working of the Courts or any law point raised by them. The officers will be released on completion of the above period.
